- Omit Av Harachamim and Tzidkas'cha.
- Today's Nassi is Shevet Shimon.

- Today's Nassi is Shevet Gad.
- According to Kabbalah, the earliest time to recite Kiddush Levanah is the seventh day from the *molad*,¹ i.e., Sunday night.

7 Nissan, 5784

- Today's Nassi is Shevet Ephraim.

- Today's Nassi is Shevet Menasheh.

9 Nissan, 5784

- Today's Nassi is Shevet Binyamin.

- Today's Nassi is Shevet Dan.

On this Day

Today is the 122st anniversary of the Rebbe's birth.

- Utilize the day for *mivtzo'im*, to learn teachings of the Rebbe, and to participate in a *farbrengen*.

“The 11th day, which is when the *nassi* of the tribe of Asher offered sacrifices, represents the infinite bond between the Jews and Hashem, and how this becomes revealed below, practically.” (Sefer Hasichos 5740, p. 399)

- We begin to say *kapitel* 123.

- Today's Nassi is Shevet Asher.
- When saying *shnayim mikra*, say both the *haftorah* of Parshas Metzora and the *haftorah* of Shabbos Hagadol (*Ve'arvah—Malachi 3:4-24*).²
